

Employment Skills Centre, Strode College, Street

Initial works comprised the demolition of existing buildings and the subsequent construction of an 'Employment Skills Centre' at Strode College.

The three storey building was constructed in a tight corner of the college, closely surrounded by other buildings and the college boundary fence.

The building sits on piles and ground beams with a cast in-situ ground floor. There is radon protection incorporated within the structure.

A steel frame provides the support for walls, floors and roofs, the first and second floors are of cast in-situ concrete on steel profiled decking and the roof is of standing seam construction.

The building is clad in a mixture of brick, spandrel panels, curtain walling and timber.
